First-year students are required to live in University-owned residence halls unless living with their parents. Exceptions to the policy must be approved by the associate vice president for Student Life.

WOLLAEGER HALL

Wollaeger Hall houses first-year men. The first floor is home to the Barbara Schoenbeck Early Learning Center. Features of this hall include air conditioning and an elevator. The average room dimension is 12' x 16'.

LUTHER HALL

Luther Hall houses first-year women on four separate wings. A tunnel connects Luther to most University facilities. The average room dimension is 12' x 18'.

RESIDENCE LIFE CENTER

The Residence Life Center is the designated residence hall for sophomore through senior students. First-year students are not eligible to be assigned to the RLC.

Making your residence hall home

2009-2010 Food Service Options

Concordia contracts with Sodexo to provide meals in the dining hall and Union Station (snack bar). Meal plans offer 19 meals per week. In addition, snacks and meals may be purchased at the Union Station. Residential students have a choice of meal plan options that feature a combination of meals in the dining hall and Flex\$. Flex\$ may be used to purchase snacks or meals at the Union Station. The plans are all the same price.

Plan options for Luther and Wollaeger:

- 19 meals per week/50 Flex\$ per semester
- 12 meals per week/150 Flex\$ per semester
- 10 meals per week/200 Flex\$ per semester

Please indicate a meal plan preference on the housing application. If no plan is specified, the student will be assigned the 12 meal/150Flex\$ plan. Students will be informed of any changes in meal plan options prior to the beginning of the fall semester. Students have the opportunity to switch plans prior to the beginning of each semester.
