- The Clinical Applications Diploma at Century must be completed prior to starting CSP's CAAHEP-accredited MSOP program, unless a student is pursuing dual enrollment.
- Concordia University, St. Paul and Century College have their own university admissions standards. These standards must be met in addition to the prerequisite coursework, in order to pursue the MS, Orthotics and Prosthetics degree. Admission to the MSOP program is not guaranteed.
- Upon conferral of the MSOP degree, students are required to complete an NCOPE-approved residency.
