<sup>1</sup>The Century program also requires a course that counts towards MnTC Goal areas 7-10. It is recommended that students complete a course from the required Goal 5 or 6 courses that also meet one goal area 7-10. Additional coursework may be required dependent on course selection.

<sup>2</sup>CSP recommends against selecting COMM 1041 for the Century communications course as it will not count toward the communication general education requirement at CSP.

<sup>3</sup>CSP recommends selecting a MnTC course that contains a lab. Non-lab MnTC Goal 3 courses will not count toward natural science general education requirement at CSP.

<sup>4</sup>Century requires that Goal 4 courses must be numbered between MATH 1025 and MATH 1082 or PHIL 1041 <sup>5</sup>ART 106 will satisfy the second humanities general education requirement.

<sup>e</sup>CSP Requires one studio major elective and one printmaking major elective. While these Century courses have been approved for general ART major electives, it is not guaranteed that these courses will fulfill specific elective requirements.

Transfer Policies:

- The above transfer guide is intended for fully completed MnTC Goal Areas only. Partially completed goal areas will be subject to course-by-course evaluation and does not guarantee transfer to a specific CSP general education area.
- An overall GPA of 2.0 or higher and major GPA of 2.0 or higher is required. (Unless the course applies toward the major, all transfer credit is accepted with a grade of Pass 'P' and does not impact your CSP GPA.).
- A minimum of 120 credits is required to earn a bachelor's degree from CSP. A minimum of 30 credits must be successfully completed at CSP and a maximum of 90 credits will be accepted in transfer.
- A minimum of half of the major credit requirements must be successfully completed at CSP.
- Completion of the full MN Transfer Curriculum will fulfill all general education credits at CSP, with the exception of Theology.
- Students may have additional credits earned from attendance at other schools, please be sure to submit all transcripts.
- The courses listed above are current as of the corresponding Academic Calendar. Course requirements are subject to change.
