<sub>2</sub>Goal Area 3 course must include a lab to count for the CSP Natural Science Gen Ed Requirement.

<sup>3</sup>Students who completed the Java Program Emphasis will have completed CSC 230, students who take either of the other two emphases will still need to complete CSC 230.

#### **Transfer Policies:**

- An overall GPA of 2.0 or higher and major GPA of 2.0 or higher is required. (Unless the course applies toward the major, all transfer credit is accepted with a grade of Pass 'P' and does not impact your CSP GPA.)
- A minimum of 120 credits is required to earn a bachelor's degree from CSP. A minimum of 30 credits must be successfully completed at CSP and a maximum of 90 credits will be accepted in transfer.
- A minimum of half of the major credit requirements must be successfully completed at CSP.
- Completion of the full MN Transfer Curriculum will fulfill all general education credits at CSP, with the exception of Theology
- Students may have additional credits earned from attendance at other schools, please be sure to submit all transcripts.
- The courses listed above are current as of the corresponding Academic Calendar Course requirements are subject to change.
